## ALMA Cigar Menu

*(From lightest to fullest)*

### **Hecha Humo Riella Superiore (Mild) - \$18.00**

Hecha Humo cigars are crafted using only the choicest tobaccos. After countless trials, the cigar has been perfected. It is smooth and creamy, with a bit of spice and hints of orange peel. It has a flawless draw and exceptionally even burn. They were blended by world renowned master-blender Augusto Reyes. The filler consists of Criollo 98, Corojo and Habano Vuelta Abajo leaves from the Dominican Republic. They are held by a Cubano San Vicente binder and covered in a flawlessly gorgeous Ecuadorian Connecticut wrapper.

**Notes:** Best enjoyed with a clean palate, and late in the afternoon, or following a meal that is light on the palate and would be greatly complimented by our Passion Fruit Sorbet.

**Suggested Pairings:** Sweet White Wines, Ron Atlantico Private Cask.

### **Camacho Connecticut Piramide (Mild to Medium) - \$14.00**

The Camacho Connecticut breaks the mold by offering a cigar on the other side of the strength spectrum. Everything you've come to love about smoking Connecticut wrapper cigars is present in the Camacho Connecticut, just enough spice to satisfy the palette of even the most seasoned cigar veteran. It is a smooth, mild to medium bodied cigar that delivers a spicy, yet mild-mannered smoking experience. It is comprised of a Connecticut Shade wrapper grown in Ecuador, a Honduran binder and Dominican/Honduran long filler tobacco.

**Notes:** This cigar would be great would be greatly enjoyed following the Florida Lobster, or Pan Seared Scallops.

**Suggested Pairings:** Chardonnay, Glen Morangie Quinta Ruba.

### **Romeo & Julieta Reserva Real Toro (Mild to Mild-Medium) - \$13.00**

#### **Romeo & Julieta Reserva Real Petites (Tin of 10 Small Cigars) - \$22.00**

This cigar is crafted using a hand selected Ecuadorian Shade wrapper and a blend of Dominican and Nicaraguan fillers. It is one of the top selling premium cigars in the nation for a reason: It is a mild, but complex cigar suitable for the novice smoker to the Aficionado. It has won too many awards and accolades to list.

**Notes:** This cigar starts out very light and then picks up at the end of the first third. The spice picks up quickly and noticeably. This cigar would suit very well after our Herb Roasted Chicken and would compliment a Warm Apple Tart quite well.

**Suggested Pairings:** Pyrat Pistol Rum, Cuba Libre.

### **La Aurora Cameroon Double Corona (Mild to Medium) - \$14.00**

La Aurora cigars draw on a rich history reaching back to 1903 when their cigar factory was established in the Dominican Republic. As the first Dominican cigar factory, the name La Aurora holds power within the cigar industry, and their cigars never disappoint. The La Aurora Cameroon is expertly rolled in the Dominican Republic, La Aurora Cameroon cigars are constructed with quality in mind to ensure an even burn from start to finish. These medium-bodied puros consist of delicious Piloto Cubano, Olor Dominicano, and Nicaraguan long fillers. The African Cameroon wrapper adds extra body while also keeping the flavors smooth.

**Notes:** Double Corona is a large cigar. Please allow yourself adequate time to enjoy this fine blend.

**Suggested Pairings:** Glenlivet 21 Year Archive. Neat.

### **Augusto Reyes Criollo Churchill (Medium) - \$16.00**

This cigar has been named 'Best of the Best' by Robb Report. Criollo combines a silky Ecuadorian-grown Connecticut wrapper with aged Cuban-seed long-fillers to create a medium-bodied smoke. The wrapper is chestnut brown in color and oily in texture, offering a nice creamy, almost buttery note to complement the cigar's smooth core of cedar, toasted wood, and leather. The smoke is deep in flavor, but refined and balanced, giving you a tasty everyday treat to please the senses.

**Notes:** The cigar may feel firm in your fingers. This is normal. This blend would fair very well with a Gran Marnier Ice Cream Souffle

**Suggested pairings:** A nice cordial...Maybe a little more Gran Marnier?

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## **H. Upmann Chairman's Reserve Dbl Corona (Medium) - \$22.00**

The Chairman's Reserve were originally blended for Ronald Perleman. These fine cigars are crafted with a flavorful, very well aged blend of filler tobaccos from Mexico and the Dominican Republic, a slightly spicy Indonesian binder and a gorgeous Connecticut Shade wrapper. The construction is flawless. It is medium-bodied, with silky smooth flavors, a creamy texture and woody notes of cedar and nuts.

**Notes:** This cigar would fit in fine following the Pan Seared Sea Scallops.

**Suggested Pairings:** Remy VSOP, a nice white wine with medium spice.

## **Camacho Pre-Embargo 6/48 (Medium) - \$50.00**

Camacho Pre-Embargo is one of the most unique cigars around. The blend begins with a vintage '99 Jamastran Corojo wrapper draped around a complex long-filler blend including authentic pre-embargo Cuban tobacco. Medium in body with a rich flavor profile, Camacho's Pre-Embargo blend brings copious amounts of flavor, including wood, leather, nuts, and spices.

**Notes:** Enjoy them while they last. They are highly limited.

**Suggested Pairing:**

## **Cohiba Aged Churchill (Medium to Medium-Full) – \$26.00**

These Cohiba Churchills have been aged a full five years. They are comprised of long-aged Dominican Cuban Seed fillers, rare Indonesian Jember binders and savory African Cameroon wrappers. They are hand-rolled into a rich-tasting, perfectly-balanced and creamy-smooth smoke. This luxurious Dominican blend is very often the one preferred by aficionados because of their complexity and depth of flavor. It is medium to full-bodied, yet not overpowering, which means smokers of every experience can enjoy this icon of great cigars.

**Notes:** This cigar is meant to complete a meal of Wagyu Churrasco and is happiest when enjoyed with a nice slice of Key Lime Pie.

**Suggested Pairings:** Hennessy Privilege VSOP.

## **Padilla Miami Edition Toro (Medium to Medium-Full) - \$16.00**

The Miami has turned the cigar industry upside down. Hand-crafted in exceedingly limited quantities, this cigar has been named one of the top 50 cigars in the world to accompany a handful of 90+ ratings. The blend is extraordinary. Each leaf of tobacco hails from the dark, fertile soils of Nicaragua and is grown from 1st generation Cuban seeds. Production is low and costs are high, yielding a very low number of cigars each year. But those that are produced are exemplary. Toasty hints of wood, cocoa and coffee smack your taste buds at various points throughout the smoke, while each is finished by a peppery aftertaste that coats the palate like syrup. 94 Rating

**Notes:** The chocolate in the Chocolate Lava Cake will really bring out the sweet, chocolatey molasses undertones in this fines cigar.

**Suggested Pairings:** Sandeman 20 Year Tawny.

## **Montecristo Medianoche No 2 Torpedo (Full) - \$30.00**

Montecristo Media Noche is a beautiful, dark cigar graced by a thick, oily Connecticut Broadleaf maduro wrapper. Under the wrapper resides a well-aged mixture of hand-selected long-fillers from Nicaragua, Peru and Dominican Republic. This hearty combination delivers ample kick but in a balanced, enjoyable manner. It delivers an intense bouquet of flavor throughout, including a cedary core complemented by hints of leather and toastiness. The aftertaste is both sweet and spicy, satisfying each part of the palate equally with a savory, full-bodied cigar experience

**Notes:** This cigar is very spicy and full-bodied. It would fit fantastically well following the Curried Lamb Shank.

**Suggested Pairing:** A nice, spicy Rum.
