



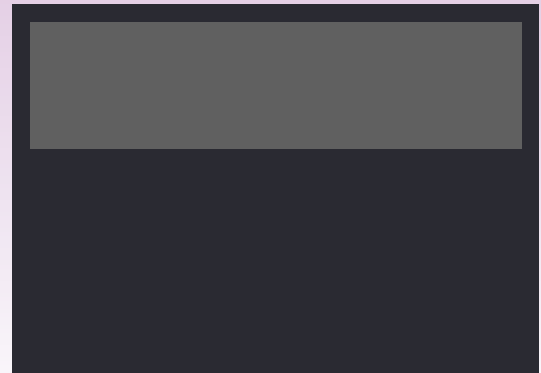

Remember, tell your parents to sign you up for the award-winning Camp Hawk. Hawks Cay is the only Florida Keys resort to offer a full day of supervised activities for us to enjoy while mom and dad are out doing their own thing.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

? Can we use the Indies Club area without being signed up for the camp?

The Indies Club is available to anyone who is staying at Hawks Cay resort. All activities and crafts listed are things that are done as a drop by activity and not associated with Camp Hawk.

? Is there a fee for activities at the Indies Club?

Most of the club activities are complimentary to Hawks Cay guests. You may notice some charge on arts & Crafts, rentals, drop off hours and camps.

? How old do you have to be to enroll in camp?

Camp hawk is for ages 5-12. Children MUST be potty trained and able to swim (with a life jacket is fine).

? Can children be dropped off during the day at the Indies Club?

If children, ages 0-12, are not in camp then they need to be accompanied by an adult. We do offer drop-off hours during some weekends where children can come do science experiments and scavenger hunts certain times throughout the day.

? Do we need to bring our own sporting equipment?

Ask your Indies Club Front Desk Attendant for any balls, putters and games that you may need during your time at the Indies Club.

? Are there bicycles for rent?

Yes.

? Do you have to sign up for the activities and crafts?

All the activities and crafts are done on a drop-in basis unless otherwise specified.

? Do they need to bring a lunch to camp?

The morning program (9am-1pm) will include a lunch and the afternoon (1pm-4pm) will include a snack.

? Do they swim in Kid's Night Out?

No swimming. Crafts, games, pizza and a movie!

? Are activities in camps different everyday/night?

Activities and games vary so that children can come to more than one program during their stay. Every counselor has things they enjoy doing which provides a very unique experience each time.



INDIES GRILLE

A quick stop by Indies Grille will appease the appetite of even the pickiest eater. Situated between the Indies Club and Pirate Ship Pool, Indies

Grille offers American childhood favorites such as hot dogs, PB&Js, nachos with cheese and, of course, ice cream. For the adults, a full bar serving mojitos, frozen cocktails, beer and wine ensures the kids aren't the only ones allowed to enjoy their favorite treats.

Teen-Friendly Florida Keys Resort Activities

We're teenagers, and we need more than the same old kids stuff. On our family vacation, we're looking for exciting things to do—like playing basketball, volleyball and kickball. We want to hit the ocean and kiteboard, kayak, snorkel and fish. We want pools where we can lay out and cool off. And we want a place where just us teens can go to play video games and make new friends.

That's why we choose Hawks Cay for this year's Florida Keys vacation. Not only does Hawks Cay offer a variety of water sports and activities found nowhere else in the islands, but it's also home to The Cove, a lounge and game room where we can hang out with and challenge each other at Wii, Guitar Hero, Baja Speedway and more. There's even a spa with special teen packages. Girls can get a facial or pedicure, and boys can get a massage after a tiring day of paddling around in the kayak.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

? Where do the teens hang out if there is not a Teen Night Out?

You can find a lot of the teens hanging out around the lagoon and the Indies Club. We are always trying to set up volleyball and basketball tournaments and fun contests for our teenagers.

? What will they do at Teen Night Out? Teen Night Out is a great way to meet other teens staying at the resort. The game room will be open until 10pm and teens can play basketball, volleyball and participate in our games and competitions.

? Do teens have to be signed into the camp?

The teens do not need to be signed into the camp by an adult. They will sign themselves in at 8pm and out at 10pm. Transportation can be called to get them back to their villa or hotel room.

? Can my teens come to the Indies Club during the day by themselves? Children ages 13 and older do not need to be accompanied by an adult. Just be sure to have the room key!

? Is there dinner at Teen Night Out? Teen Night Out has a cover charge of \$5 which includes a drink and a snack (popcorn, chips, etc)

? Are there any daily activities for teens?

Teens are more than welcome to participate in our arts and crafts and pool competitions. We will separate age groups to keep the competition fair!

? Can my teens rent bikes without a parent?

We do ask that children under 16 years of age have a parent's signature to rent the bike out, but they are allowed to ride around by themselves. Florida law also states that children under the age of 16 have to wear a protective helmet (included in rental).

? Can kids buy things without their parents being there?

Children can buy things at the Indies Club and Grill but will need to have a room key.

? Are there activities at the main pool and lagoon?

Absolutely. We have mini kayaks in the lagoon where we do races and we have cannonball competitions, etc. in the main pools and off the floating dock.

? Do you have to sign up for Teen Night Out?

It is not necessary to sign up ahead of time for Teen Night Out.
