What's New In The Florida Keys

WHERE TO STAY

One of the islands' top hotels just got better, thanks to a \$18 million, top-to-bottom renovation. The massive overhaul to the 60-acre property involved a mixture of facelifts and expansions, including the addition of two new luxury penthouses and 16 family suites; a complete redesign of the lobby (a 1,300-gallon lobby aquarium will be installed later this summer); and a new relaxation area reserved for adults, complete with a pool and five private cabanas. Updates to nearby Marina Walk (such as new restaurant Angler and Ale) later this year will round out the
