September is one of the ideal times to visit The Florida Keys—the **summer crowds have left and the weather is great for water activities** (scuba diving, snorkeling, fishing, kayaking and paddle boarding). Post Hurricane Irma, a lot of the area has been rebuilt, including Hawks Cay Resort, which underwent a \$50 million-dollar renovation. The brand new resort has fresh dining concepts including Sixty-One Prime, a chop house with signature seafood and prime cuts. The resort is known for being **family-friendly**, **but now has a Oasis Cay adults-only area**. Rent a convertible and drive down the scenic Overseas Highway—in September you won't hit much traffic—and make stops at famous landmarks like John Pennekamp, Robbie's, and Morada Bay.
